

Digging Deeper: Acts 2:42–47

Day 1

This is a BIG week Scripture and sermon wise. The verses this week were the verses that MACC was founded on. Take some time today and read and pray over these verses. Why do you think MACC was founded on these verses? What is their significance?

Day 2

Today, read Acts 2:42 and then consider devoting themselves to the “Apostles teaching.” What is the scope, depth, and breadth of this scripture? Consider 2 Timothy 3:16. What do you think the Lord means to devote oneself to this? Pray the Lord may lead you in this area.

Day 3

Today, read Acts 2:42, and then consider devoting themselves to the “fellowship and the breaking of bread.” What is the scope, depth, and breadth of this scripture? Consider Hebrews 10:25. What do you think the Lord means to devote oneself to this? Pray the Lord may lead you in this area.

Day 4

Today, read Acts 2:42, and then consider devoting themselves to “prayer.” What is the scope, depth, and breadth of this scripture? Consider Hebrews, 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18. What do you think the Lord means to devote oneself to this? Pray the Lord may lead you in this area.

Day 5:

Read Acts 2:43. Today, we will consider what it means to have all things in common. Consider the prior verse and the relationship to this verse. Consider what you have in common with all believers now, and consider what the Lord is telling us in this early Church. What are the similarities, and what are the differences? How can we as the local Church come closer to this 1st century Church. Spend some time praying for our Church today.

Day 6

Today, read Acts 2:45–47. Consider the community of believers and the observations from the scriptures. Review Ephesians 4:1–3 and the Spirit of unity and the bond of peace. Compare the unity, fellowship, and love of the 1st century Church. Again today, spend some time praying for our Church and that we may be faithful to this unity.
