This week will be a Bible Study in which you will look up the verse, consider what the Lord's meaning is, pray, mediate, and ask the Lord how you can apply.

Day 1: [Proverbs 14:29](#) ESV /

Whoever is slow to anger has great understanding, but he who has a hasty temper exalts folly.

[Psalm 37:8](#) ESV /

Refrain from anger, and forsake wrath! Fret not yourself; it tends only to evil.

[Proverbs 15:1](#) ESV /

A soft answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger.

[James 1:20](#) ESV /

For the anger of man does not produce the righteousness of God.

[Ephesians 4:26](#) ESV /

Be angry and do not sin; do not let the sun go down on your anger,

Day 2: [James 1:19](#) ESV /

Know this, my beloved brothers: let every person be quick to hear, slow to speak, slow to anger;

[Ecclesiastes 7:9](#) ESV /

Be not quick in your spirit to become angry, for anger lodges in the heart of fools.

[Proverbs 29:11](#) ESV /

A fool gives full vent to his spirit, but a wise man quietly holds it back.

[Proverbs 19:11](#) ESV /

Good sense makes one slow to anger, and it is his glory to overlook an offense.

Day 3: [Proverbs 16:32](#) ESV /

Whoever is slow to anger is better than the mighty, and he who rules his spirit than he who takes a city.

A hot-tempered man stirs up strife, but he who is slow to anger quiets contention.

But now you must put them all away: anger, wrath, malice, slander, and obscene talk from your mouth.

But I say to you that everyone who is angry with his brother will be liable to judgment; whoever insults his brother will be liable to the council; and whoever says, 'You fool!' will be liable to the hell of fire.

God is a righteous judge, and a God who feels indignation every day.

[Psalm 37:8-9](#) ESV /

Refrain from anger, and forsake wrath! Fret not yourself; it tends only to evil. For the evildoers shall be cut off, but those who wait for the LORD shall inherit the land.

Beloved, never avenge yourselves, but leave it to the wrath of God, for it is written, "Vengeance is mine, I will repay," says the Lord."

Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all malice. Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you.
